



What are 'Costume Distribution Days'?

During the week of April 22-27, every class will try on their recital costume in class and take them home! We ask that a grownup attends class with their dancer (if the dancer is under age 10). Teachers will go over costuming details and answer any questions you may have regarding the upcoming recital!

Choose the showtime you plan to attend and choose your seats. You can add tickets to multiple shows into your cart before checking out. Double check your showtimes and seats before purchasing as there are no refunds or exchanges.

Tickets are limited to five (5) per-family per-show for the first 48 hours (9 a.m. on 4/2 until 8:59 a.m. on 4/4). This is to ensure everyone who wants to attend has the opportunity to get tickets. On April 4th at 9 a.m., ticket sales to all shows will be open for unlimited purchase quantities. If you need more than 5 tickets, we strongly recommend purchasing the first five on 4/2 and then logging back in on 4/4 to purchase the remaining tickets needed.



TICKET SALES 411

Recital tickets go on sale 4/2 at 9 a.m.

Tickets are \$28 and incur a processing fee of \$2 from the ticketing agency.

For the first TWO days (4/2 - 4/4) each family will be limited to purchasing only FIVE tickets to each show. After this two-day period, on 4/4 at 9 a.m., you may go back into the ticketing sales site and purchase as many more tickets as you would like.

We limit tickets for a short period in this way to be sure that each of our families has an opportunity to purchase tickets to the show their child is in. Ipswich Performing Arts Center has limited capacity. To be fair to everyone, we implement this temporary limitation. Thank you for understanding!

Tickets are reserved seating.

Ticket Sales At-A-Glance:

4/2: Tickets go on sale at 9 a.m. (restricted to five tickets per family per show)4/4: Ticket restriction lifted at 9 a.m.5/11: Ticket sales end - it's show day!

No tickets will be sold at the door! Reserved seating. Ticket cost is \$28.

Dress Rehearsal

Our dress rehearsals this year are on Monday, May 6th and Tuesday, May 7th. Please look to see when your dancer rehearses and mark the dates on your calendars as it is extremely important that everyone attends!

Who: Everyone!

What: Dress rehearsal (come in costume with hair and makeup complete!)
Where: Ipswich High School Performing Arts Center
When: Monday, 5/6 and/or Tuesday, 5/7 (refer to schedule)
Why: So that dancers can practice on the big stage!

- Please make every effort to arrive on time and in costume, with hair and makeup complete! We are on a tight schedule and your cooperation is appreciated!
- After your dancer's last routine, you may leave the theater. Be sure you have all your costume pieces and dance shoes!

Arrival: 10 minutes prior to your dancer's first routine as noted on the dress rehearsal schedule

Dismissal: after your dancer's last routine

Where to report upon arrival: please come directly into the audience and sit with your class. We will call your dancer onstage when it is time for them to rehearse.

Is this a drop-off event? Not for most. Please plan to stay in the audience with your dancer if they are not at an age where they can be safely independent. We will be busy onstage and won't be able to watch any unattended children.

Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures at Recital

If your dancer is in the 10:30 a.m. performance only...

- Check-in between 9:45 and 10:00 a.m. Please walk your dancer into Ipswich High School and retrieve your 'pick-up' bracelet. Make sure your dancer arrives in their first costume, with their hair and makeup already complete. Pack them a backpack filled with all their necessary dance shoes, extra tights, safety pins, bobby pins, etc. Also feel free to pack them anything to keep busy (but nothing messy or valuable!) Don't forget a water bottle and a healthy, nut-free snack. If they have a change of costume, please bring that costume on a hanger in a plastic bag or garment bag. You will hand off your dancer to our staff and you then you may wait for the theater to open. Enjoy the show!
- For pick-up after the Finale routine, please go to the area where you dropped off your dancer. Show your pick-up bracelet and you will have access to the holding area.
- Please note that everyone (including preschoolers) is in the Finale routine, which is the last routine of each recital. Please do not plan to get your dancer prior to the end of the recital!
- Please be sure all of your dancer's items are labelled with their name!

If your dancer is in the 1:00 p.m. performance only...

- Check-in between 12:15-12:30 p.m. Please walk your dancer into Ipswich High School and retrieve your 'pick-up' bracelet. Make sure your dancer arrives in their first costume, with their hair and makeup already complete. Pack them a backpack filled with all their necessary dance shoes, extra tights, safety pins, bobby pins, etc. Also feel free to pack them anything to keep busy (but nothing messy or valuable!) Don't forget a water bottle and a healthy, nut-free snack. If they have a change of costume, please bring that costume on a hanger in a plastic bag or garment bag. You will hand off your dancer to our staff and you then you may wait for the theater to open. Enjoy the show!

Pack them a backpack filled with all their necessary dance shoes, extra tights, safety pins, bobby pins, etc. Also feel free to pack them anything to keep busy (but nothing messy or valuable!) Don't forget a water bottle and a healthy, nut-free snack. If they have a change of costume, please bring that costume on a hanger in a plastic bag or garment bag. You will hand off your dancer to our staff and you then you may wait for the theater to open. Enjoy the show!

Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures at Recital, continued

If your dancer is in multiple performances...

- Please be mindful of the drop-off time for your dancer's shows by referencing the information on the previous page.
- If a dancer leaves between shows, please sign-out on the table outside the cafeteria.
- Parents with dancers in back-to-back shows have the option to leave your dancer with us between performances. Please only leave your dancer if they can be independent between performances. If you plan to leave them with us, be sure to send them with a nut-free lunch/snacks! We will ask students that stay with us between performances to remain in the cafeteria area, and change out of their costume into comfy clothes while eating. Thank you!
- Grownups with a bracelet may bring dancers food to eat between shows by coming to the cafeteria or the dancer's dressing room.
- Grownups with a bracelet are welcome to come to their dancer's dressing area between shows to help organize dance bags, costumes, etc., and get their dancer prepped for the subsequent performance.
- All dancers in back-to-back shows should be in the cafeteria area and not wandering around the theater.
- If your dancer is in the first show and the last show (and not the middle show), we request that you leave the theater until your next call-time to help us stay organized and keep track of who is with us at the theater.
- Follow the instructions on the previous page for drop-off procedures.



- Ipswich High School is located at 134 High Street in Ipswich, Massachusetts
- When you enter the doors, follow the hall to the left
- Take a right, down the stairs
- We will have a table set up to check your dancer in

We ask that all grownups say their goodbyes immediately after checking in and receiving your bracelet. We only let dancers past the table at drop-off for security reasons. Thank you for understanding!



Hair for Recital


Every female identifying dancer should have their hair in a middle-parted, low bun.

Please use gel and hairspray! We don't want any wispies! Use bobby pins to secure the bun, and a hairnet helps keep flyaways at bay. Any headpieces/barrettes typically go to the right of the head, but check with your instructor to be sure!

Male identifying dancers should have a neat appearance.



Make-up for Recital



Stage lights wash out our features, so dancers wear makeup to better show their smiling faces! Please help your dancer apply a little makeup prior to arriving at photo days, dress rehearsal and recital. Please do not send your young dancer with lipstick they can easily access alone as they could take creative liberties with application :)

> Lips: red Eyes: brown palette

Male identifying dancers can wear a little powder and lip color if they choose but it is not mandatory.





FAQ

How do I know what show my dancer is in?

In this packet, you will find a list of who is in which show.

When do tickets go on sale?

April 2nd - in this packet there is information on how to order tickets. Everything will be done online.

Are the dress rehearsals mandatory?

Yes! Dress rehearsal provides an opportunity for all dancers to rehearse their routines on the big stage! Doing this gives familiarity to the students and makes for a much smoother recital day!

Do we have to come to the photo days at the studio?

Photos are optional. If you would like to have your dancer's photo taken in their costume by a professional photographer, follow the link to book a photo slot on the 'Photo Information' page in this packet.

What is the procedure for dropping my dancer off at the recital?

In this packet there is a detailed information regarding drop-off and pick-up procedures for the recital day. If you still have questions, you can email hello@DanceElevate.com.

Where do I get the required tights and shoes for my dancer?

Locally, we recommend 'On Your Toes' in Peabody for tights and shoes.

How does my dancer need to wear their hair?

Every female identifying dancer will wear their hair in a center-parted low bun. Directions are within this packet. Male identifying dancers should have a neat appearance.

Does my dancer need to wear makeup?

Yes! Please reference the makeup tutorial within this packet for more information.

When do we bring costumes home?

There is a costume distribution week, April 22 - April 27, where we ask a parent to attend class with their dancer to learn about their costume(s) and bring them home.

How long are the shows?

The first show is approximately 45 minutes with no intermission. The second and third shows are approximately 90 minutes with a 15 minute intermission.

Does my child have to do the finale routine?

Yes, all dancers are in the Finale routine! The finale is the last routine of each show and it is tradition for recitals to end with all of the dancers on the stage for a final bow. Dancers will wear their recital t-shirt over their costume, or they can pair it with comfortable bottoms (black leggings for example).
